Dear Colleagues

We have been delighted by the enthusiasm for the second SCOPE meeting planned for 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> September 2026 in Oxford, UK. Thank you for agreeing to be part of this event.

SCOPE meetings are different from other Urology conferences – SCOPE is a forum for bold ideas, dynamic conversations, and real-world problem-solving! Half of the audience will be clinicians with an interest in technology and innovation and the other half will be representatives from most of the companies involved in designing, manufacturing and distributing endourological products for clinical use. Instead of separating Industry from clinicians in an exhibition hall, there will be no industry booths and everyone will be in the auditorium together. The aim is to fully engage everyone in discussion around innovation in endourology.

For those **chairing** the sessions please engage the audience (both clinicians and Industry representatives) and lead the questioning giving as many people as possible a chance to speak. Please ensure the presentations run to time. We have designed the timetable to have plenty of time for discussion and questions because we believe the best learning happens through conversation. Encourage participation by:

- Directing specific questions to **clinicians** about real-world applications and challenges of innovation.
- Challenging **industry representatives** to reflect on manufacturing, scalability and commercial viability.

- Inviting audience input—pose open-ended questions that spark debate and fresh perspectives.
- Use live feedback tools (e.g show of hands)

For **presenters**, please challenge yourselves to step beyond standard presentations and embrace a more interactive and engaging format. Where appropriate please consider “storytelling” (frame your presentation around real-world experience and include both successes and failures). Consider inclusion of polls to engage the audience. Please keep presentations concise—think TED Talk style. This will allow for deeper discussions.

To create a cohesive and insightful experience, please liaise with fellow speakers in your session to:


- Ensure your content complements rather than duplicates theirs.
- Identify areas for synergy
- Align key themes and takeaways for a more structured conference flow.

The course organisers will contact the presenters and chairs from each session to connect the speakers and to help coordinate and focus the sessions.

We hope that this new meeting format will bring a new dimension to Endourology conferences and become a pivotal space for innovation and impact.
